Red Rock Canyon nominated as "Last Chance Landscape"

The Red Rock Canyon Committee has submitted an application nominating the Red Rock Canyon property for *Scenic America's* 2002 list of "Last Chance Landscapes".

Each year, *Scenic America* selects approximately ten threatened landscapes which can potentially be preserved to be listed in its national Last Chance Landscapes list. An important criterion for *Scenic America's* selections of its Last Chance Landscapes is the visual significance of the landscape as seen from commonly traveled routes. Thus, the visual character of the Red Rock Canyon property as viewed from Colorado Springs and the Garden of the Gods was highlighted in the application.

The Last Chance Landscapes application was prepared by Kevin Johnson. In preparing the application, Kevin sought suggestions from several people including Steve Castle whose efforts helped to get Union Meadows chosen as a Last Chance Landscape.

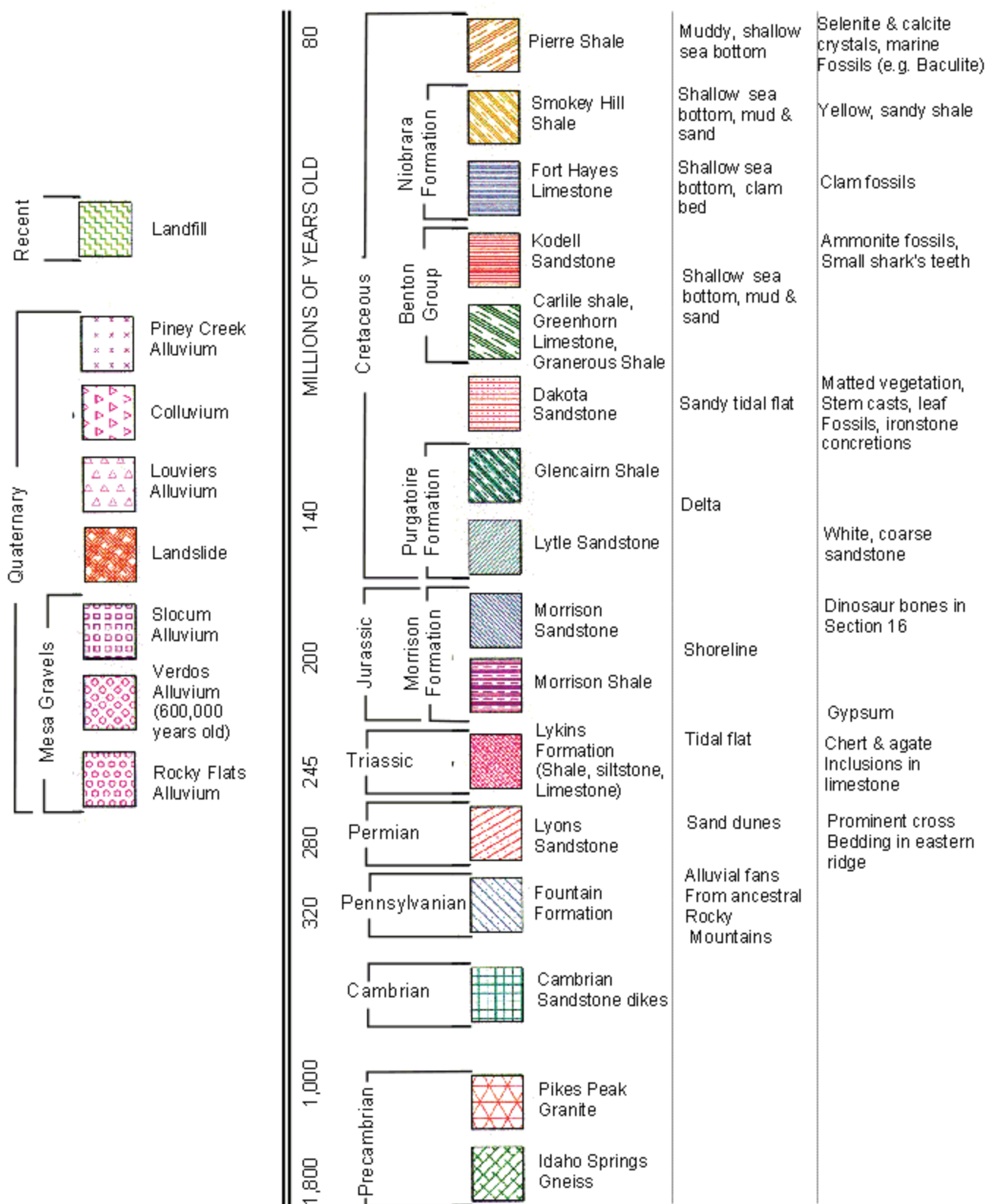

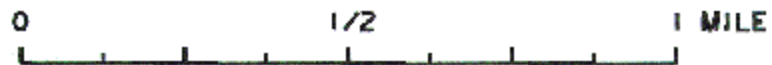
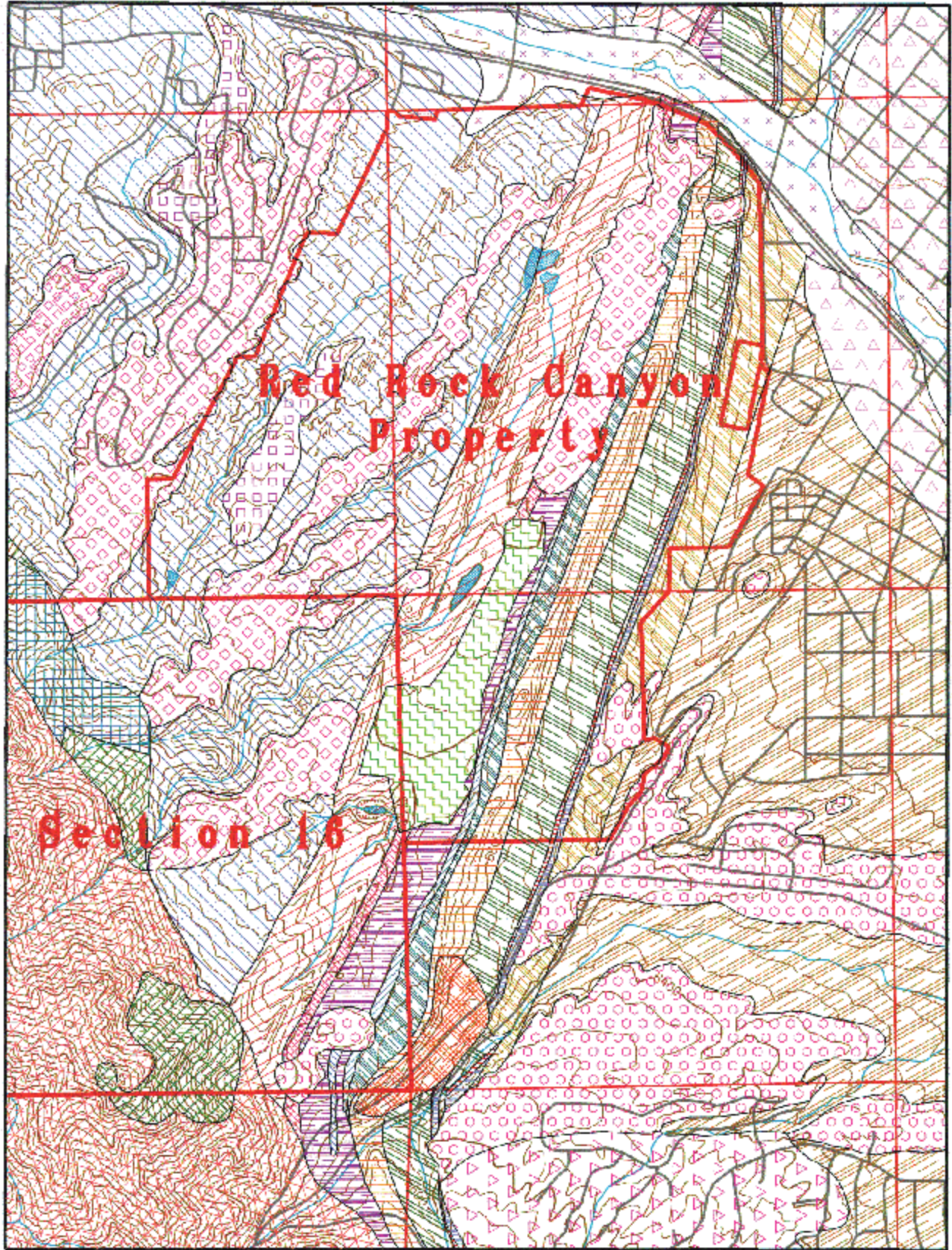
